PLAN OF MANAGEMENT

In line with our stated aim, we have elected a sub-committee to prepare a Plan of Management of the bush areas west of the Lane Cove River, to the north approximately to where the Comenarra crosses the valley and south to the end of Kissing Point Road. The study will be under the direction of Robin Buchanan, B.A. (Hons), who has had considerable experience in this field of work, and we will be further advised by Dr Peter Myerscough, local resident and Senior Lecturer in Biology at Sydney University.

BUSH REGENERATION GROUP.

STEP has a working group using the Joan Bradley method of Bush Regeneration, the only sure and safe technique for eradicating weeds and used by such bodies as the National Trust.
